- Current Masjid was built in 1997

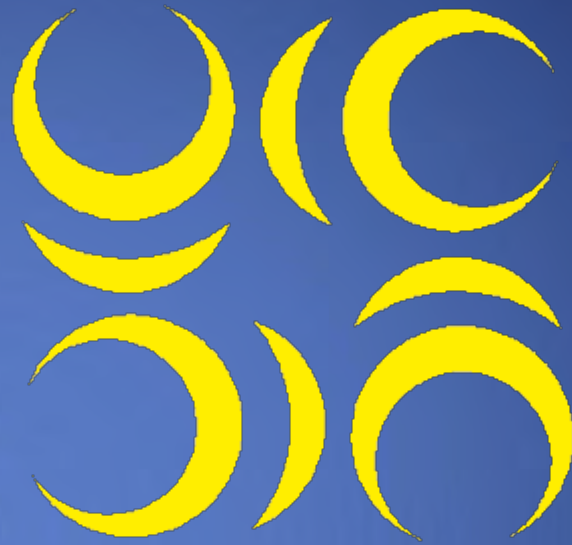


Current Community Challenges

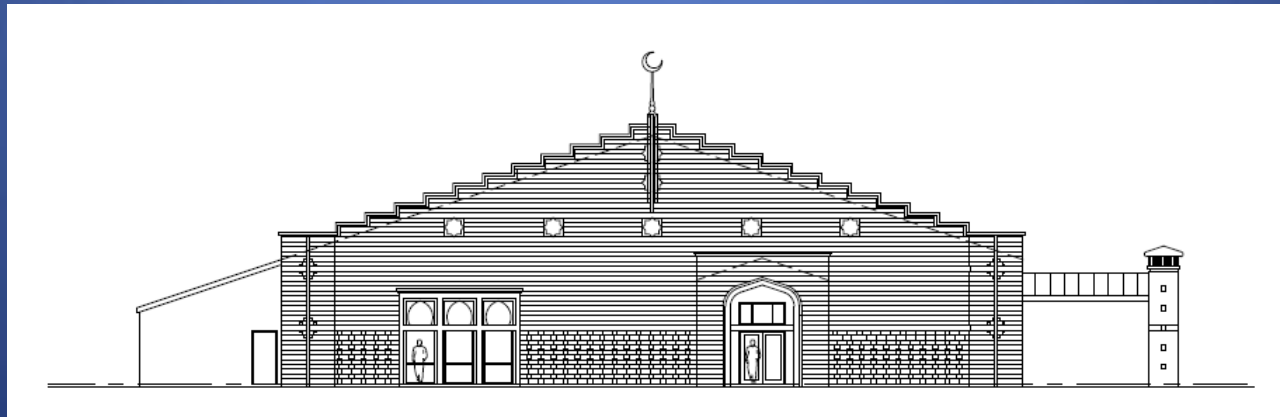
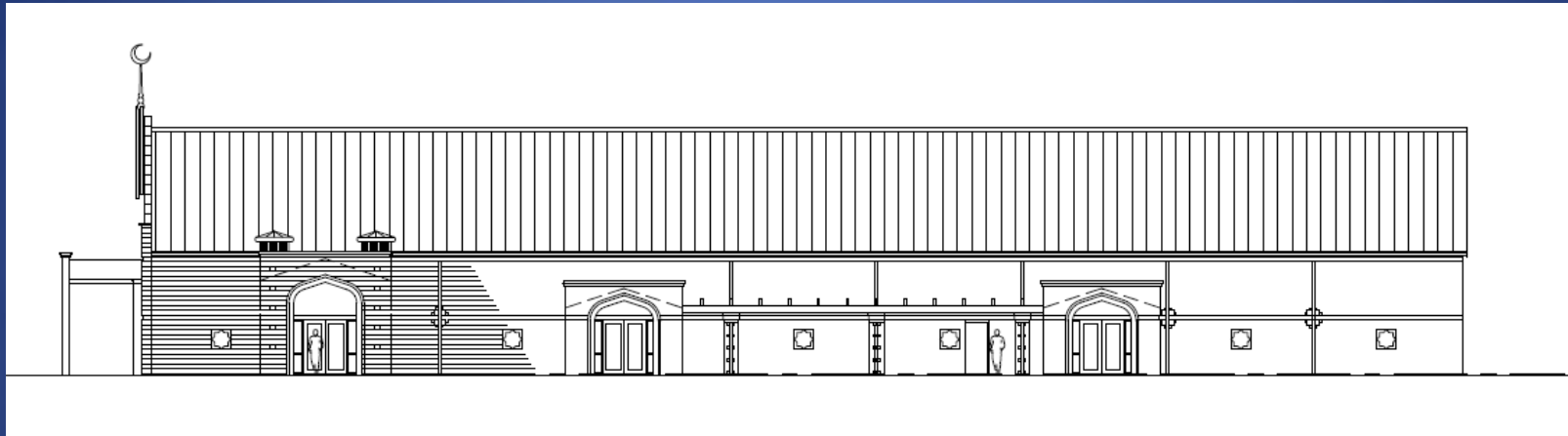
Vision

To provide the Muslims of the Upstate with a place of worship, a community center, and a place of education

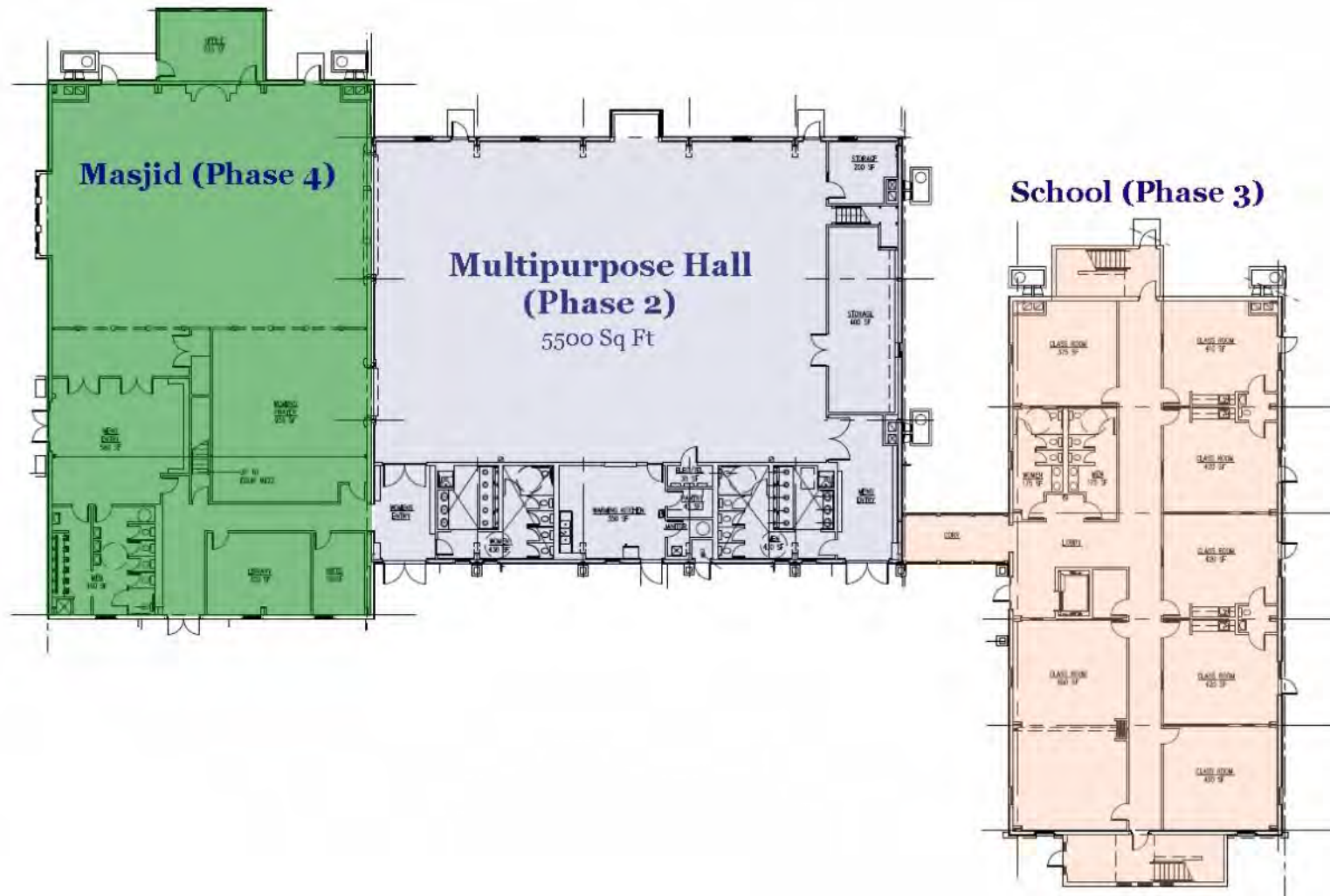
Mission

After acquiring the necessary property, ISG seeks to establish the UIC – composed of a masjid, community hall, and a full-time primary school

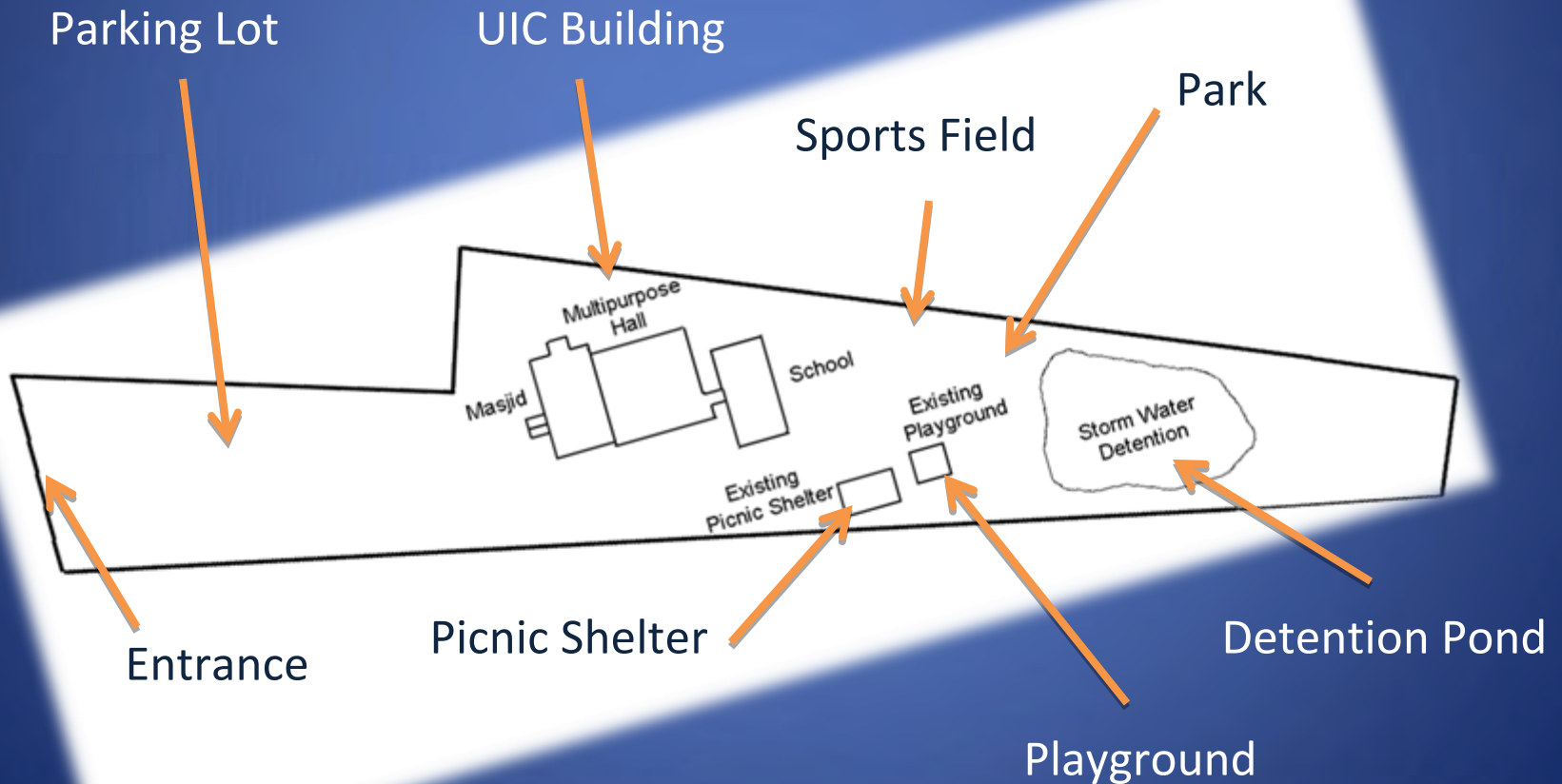

Phased Development

Phase 1

- Land Development—All “horizontal” development work including clearing the land, obtaining grading permits, building the parking lot and detention pond, etc.

Phase 2

- Building Construction 1—Complete multipurpose hall construction for occupancy.

Phase 3

- Building Construction 2—Build a school building to house the community’s full-time Islamic school.

Phase 4

- Building Construction 3—The Masjid and all remaining community facilities will be constructed and/or installed.
